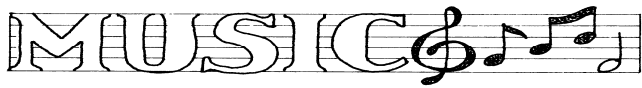

Blood drive—October 8

FALL into a lifesaving habit - GIVE BLOOD at Our Savior Lutheran Church's Blood Drive - Thursday, October 8 from 3:00PM until 7:00PM at the Fellowship Hall. Blood is constantly needed - one out of every ten hospital patients needs blood. 100 percent of blood used in local hospitals comes from Michigan Community Blood Centers. Even if you were deferred from donating because the level of iron in your blood was too low, please don't let that stop you from trying to give blood again. Your iron level varies from day to day and it may be high enough for you to give blood the next time you try. Some foods that are more iron rich are liver, beef roast, beef hamburger, roasted turkey, clams, oysters, shrimp, veal, pork, canned ham, beans, lentils, cooked spinach, tomato juice, bran flakes, cream of wheat, gingerbread, dried apricots, dates, prunes (especially prune juice) and watermelon. If you have questions regarding donation requirements please call the local donor services at 774-2300.
