John Burningham was born in England in 1936. Ed Young was born in China in 1931.

Both men have received numerous awards for their children's books.

"Hey, Get Off Our Train!" by John Burningham tells of a young boy who is told to get into bed immediately because he has school tomorrow. He does get into bed and then takes an imaginary trip on his toy train and rescues several endangered animals. As each animal approaches the train, the boy/engineer shouts, "Hey Get Off Our Train!" The children love to "read" those pages with me.

"Seven Blind Mice" was written by Ed Young and received a Caldecott Honor Award.

His paper collage illustrations help to capture the wit and humor of this tale based on the ancient fable of the Blind Men and the Elephant. (This book indirectly helps little ones to review their colors and the days of the week also)!

We have few books by these authors and I hope to be able to purchase a few more some day.
