Senior Pastor Call Committee Progress Report

On Wednesday, December 12, the Call Committee of Our Savior Lutheran Church unanimously decided to recommend to the January Voters Assembly that Pastor Swem be Called as Senior Pastor. This would begin when Pastor Fleming serves Our Savior Church less than 60% during his transition to serving as executive director of Doxology, a charitable nonprofit that provides training in pastoral skills. Since Pastor Swem will likely be Called as Senior Pastor of Our Savior Church, a Call Committee has been formed and is seeking the names of candidates for the Principal position.
