This year, we have been using FastDirect blasts which send out closing information through text messages and email. If you haven't signed up for text messages already, please do so! I have spoken with four parents in the last week who have been concerned about how the snow days of the last two weeks will affect our children and their education. The State of Michigan mandates a 180 day school year for all public schools. As a private school we comply with this standard and see great benefit for our students.
