From the Principal

At the end of the year, it is good to reflect on all of the blessings of the past year and to consider the new opportunities for the coming school year. I have been so richly blessed to serve as the principal over the past years, getting to know your children, seeing their faith grow, and seeing them grow in wisdom. Over the past four years I have seen such wonderful growth in maturity of these young men and women! As we close this chapter, it is tempting to think that it is the end, but this is not the case, for in Christ, we only reach the telos-the end, when we finally reside with Him in heaven. The Growth Team has increased name recognition of our school, and devoted preschool families have also increased interest in the school--we've had 17 parties contact the school and given 8 tours already this year including 2 this week. Our teachers are continuing to investigate Classical Education and to examine ways to invest in our students and to innovate in their classrooms. As we continue this journey, I pray that God blesses us all richly!
